Executive summary

This document summarises the updates of the dissemination actions within the SECONOMICS project (M19-M36)

Section 1 describes the updates of the dissemination actions related to the website, Twitter, press releases and newsletters. 7 press releases in different languages have been produced. HORIZON - the EU Research & Innovation Magazine - also published a 1-page article about SECONOMICS. 5 newsletters have been produced and are available in pdf version to be downloaded from the website. Around 200 issues of the printed version of the newsletter have been distributed. Around 160 issues in electronic version were distributed by direct mailing actions.

Section 2 provides the table of publications about SECONOMICS, More than 70 scientific articles have published, including 7 that have been added to the OpenAIRE Repository.

Section 3 provides the table of dissemination activities within the SECONOMICS project. In terms of outreach SECONOMICS was present at more than 50 conferences and workshops; the project was officially presented at 8 events. To increase reach to practitioners, SECONOMICS good practice has been published on ePractice.eu.

Section 4 provides the table of synergies and contacts. Synergies have been established with the First.org SIG Team for the definition of the Common Vulnerability Scoring System Standard CVSS v3, the UK Government, ACI Europe, ENAC and UITP Security Commission amongst others.

Finally, section 5 provides the update of the table of Key Performance Indicators related to the dissemination activities achieved during the project.

In addition to other data (e.g. polls and surveys), the information provided by the web statistics tool will allow to recognise our target groups and improve the design and content of the website.

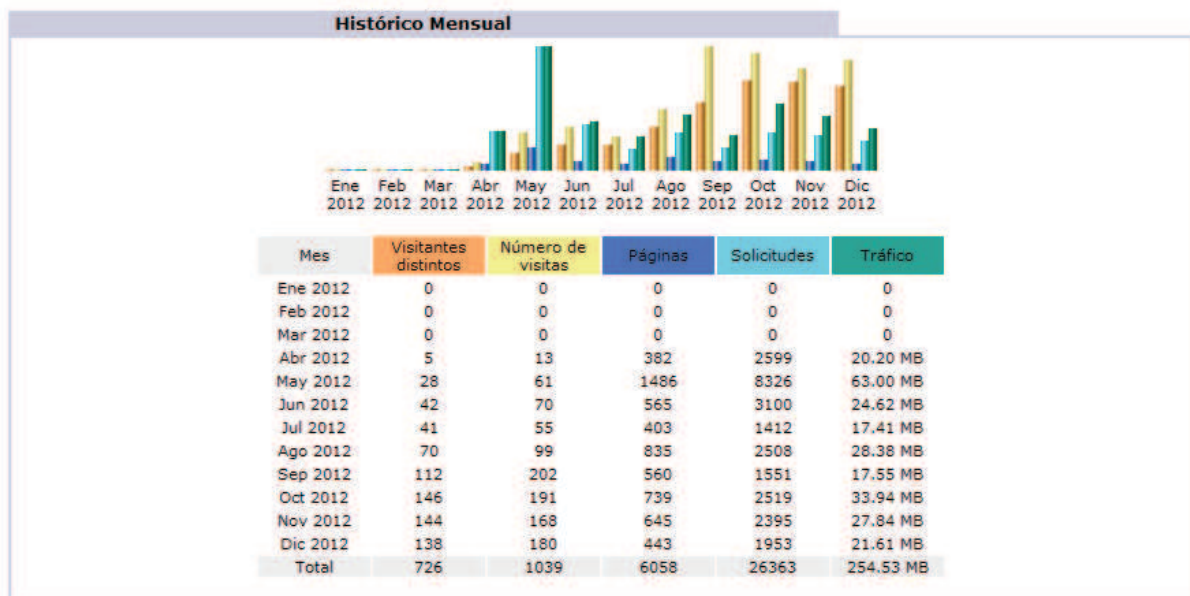


Figure 1: SECONOMICS website statistics in 2012

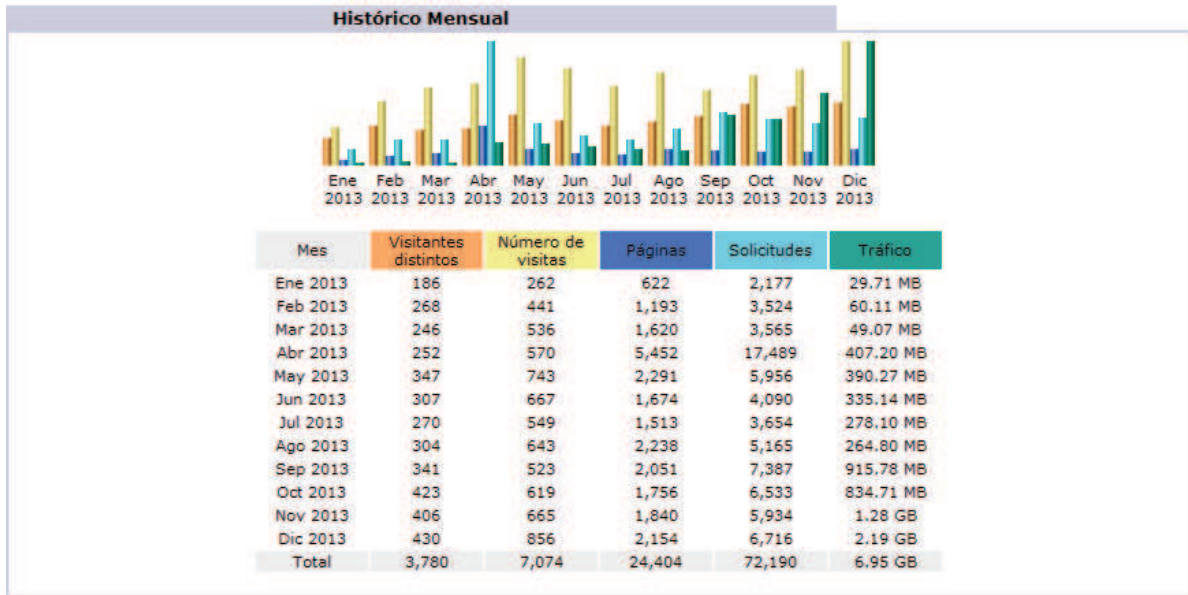


Figure 2: SECONOMICS website statistics in 2013

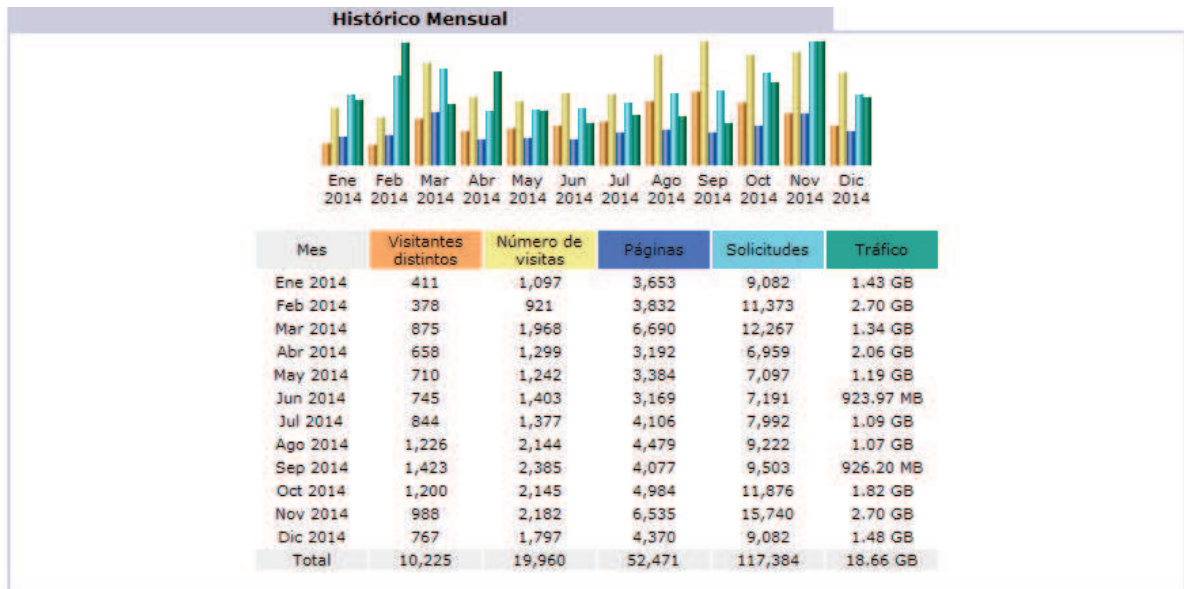


Figure 3: SECONOMICS website statistics in 2014

The total amount of hits since the project started is higher than 28000 - 56 times higher than the Key Performance indicator for the website (see section KPIs: Measuring the impact of dissemination actions)

Traffic has exponentially increased in the last years due to the constant uploads of materials, specially the newsletters. The maximum number of different visitors in a month (1423) has been reached in September 2014, during the preparation and announcement of the SECONOMICS Summit.

Since the Twitter account was activated, the visits and the downloading rates in the SECONOMICS website have increased.

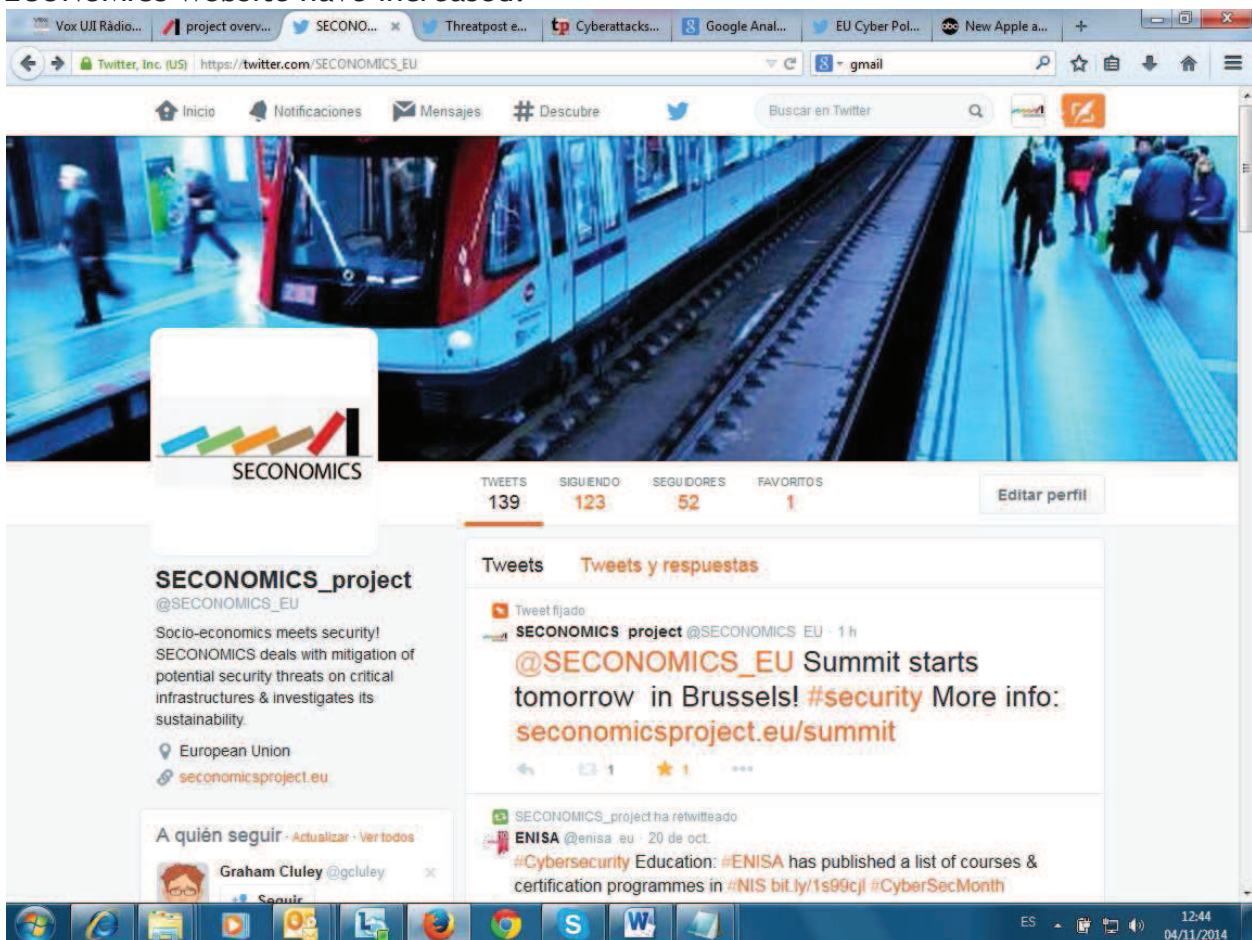


Figure 4: SECONOMICS Twitter account

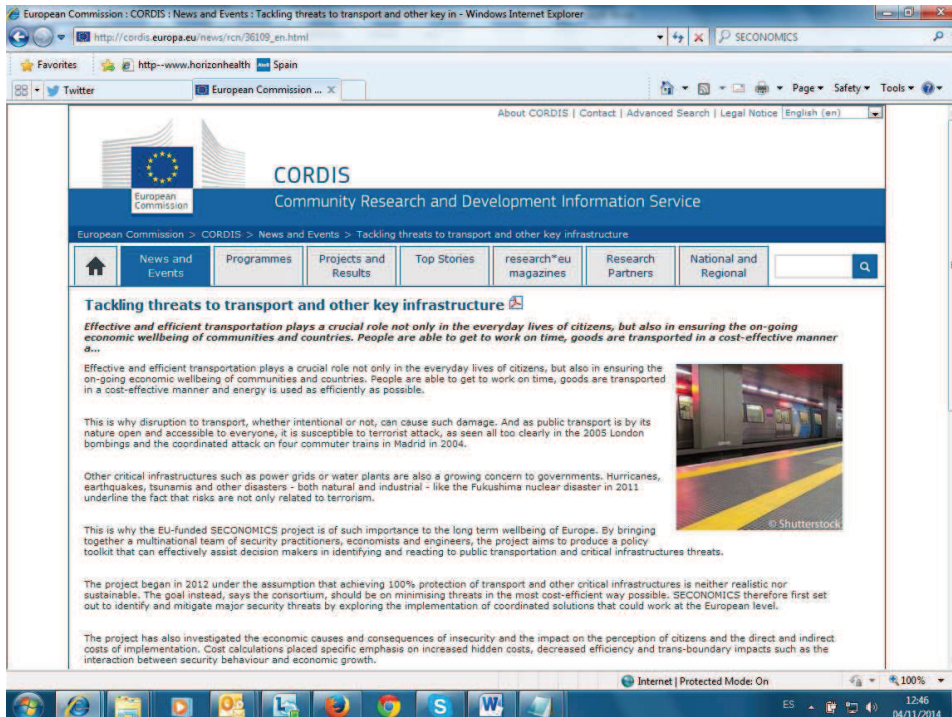

SOCIO-ECONOMICS FOR BALANCED AND EFFECTIVE SECURITY SOLUTIONS

A cross-disciplinary project combining game theory, systems modelling, risk analysis and social policy is offering a socio-economic rationale to security policymaking. Its unified framework will contribute to the design of effective security policy and investment, and public acceptance of security.

Funded by the EU, the project **SECONOMICS** (Socio-economics meets security) is grounded in a case study approach to scoping issues in security management. Case studies are being carried out in relation to three key topics: critical infrastructure, airport security, and regional and urban transport.

With a scientific focus on the public economics and social policy implications of security, researchers aim to develop tools for assessing regulatory policies in terms of effectiveness and sustainability. Consideration of security technology, public attitudes and attacking behaviour will help in the design of experiments that delineate the effectiveness of various policy regimes.

Another area of investigation deals with the mechanism for generating security risks and the dynamics of attackers in particular. Models employing game theory of adversarial risk analysis have been developed for better understanding how attackers create security risk by exploiting vulnerabilities.

Major effort has been dedicated to engaging with the broader industry community to promote SECONOMICS' goals and publicise its findings. Extensive surveys of the three case study topics were carried out over the first half of the three-year project.

Surveys on security requirements offer key insights into current, emerging and future threats. These relate to a better understanding of airport security and associated technologies, regulatory mechanisms relevant to critical infrastructure, and issues in regional and urban transport.

Progress has also been made with regard to the use of security metrics in airports and in critical infrastructure, as well as for collecting crime data. Other activities to date include a summer school designed to measure public attitudes to risk as reflected through contemporary media.

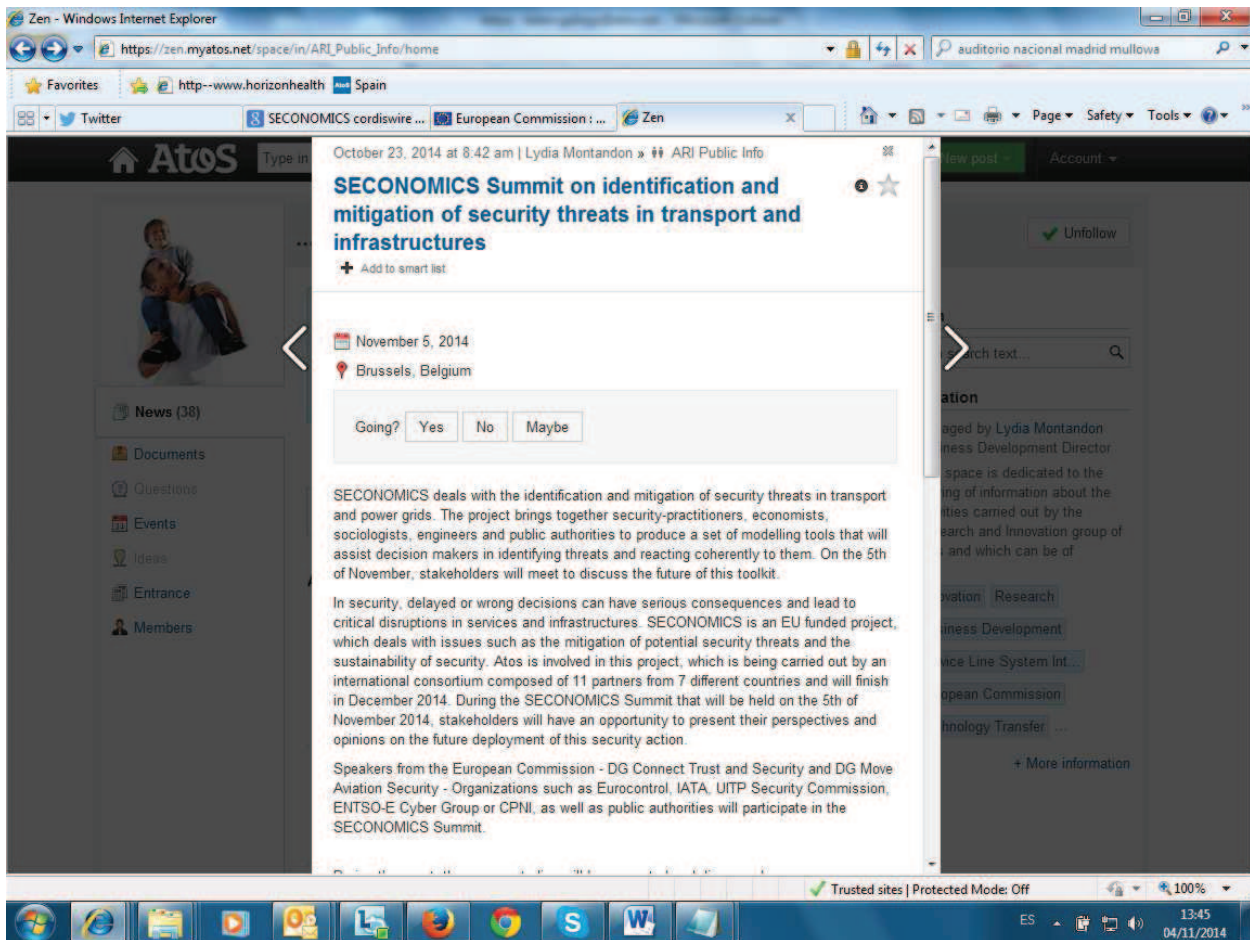
SECONOMICS endeavours to highlight future and emerging threats that may arise in the three focus topics. Such knowledge can be used to refine models for indicating future directions for security risks and the evolution of threats.

The project's envisioned framework will ultimately help guide decisions in key areas in order to achieve effective policies and efficient security. Emphasising cost versus risk reduction, SECONOMICS' pro-social approach will also help ensure the social contract with society is maintained.

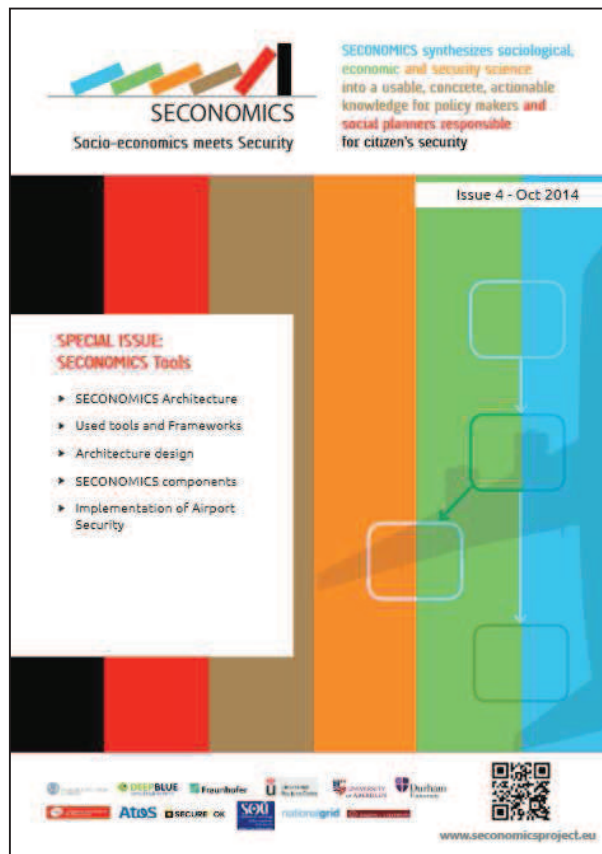

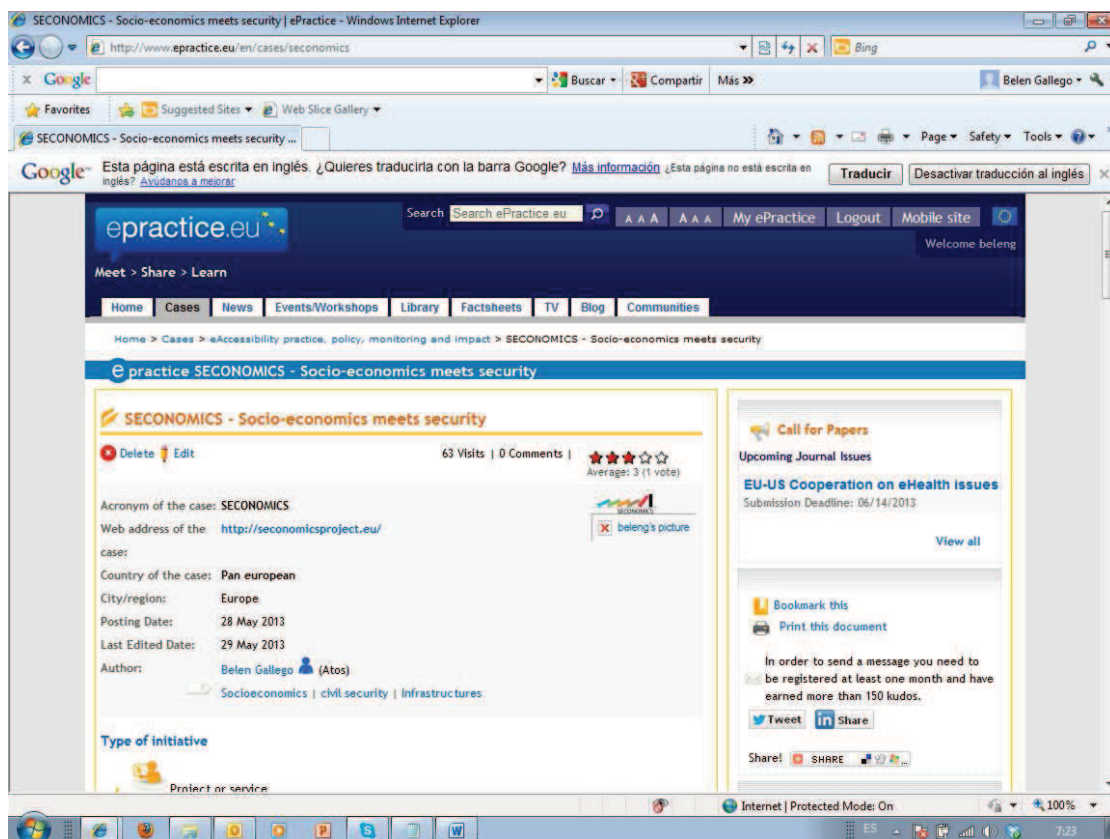


Figure 5: SECONOMICS in ePractice
